**Q: Spring is here! I see my fuel economy improving, so our drivers must be performing better, right?**

**A:** Don't confuse weather with progress. Along with spring comes improved KPI's, but they aren't necessarily due to focused efforts on behavioral changes. Below are a couple of weather-based KPI Improvements.

MPG – Fuel economy has spiked over the past couple of months. As temperatures rise, summer diesel fuel blend starts making its way into the fuel stations and vehicles. As the summer blend burns more efficiently, naturally it improves your fuel economy, emerging from winter.
